2 months before event

- ✓ Select date and reserve space
- ✓ Recruit volunteers
 - o planners
 - o facilitators
 - o set up and clean up volunteers
 - o greeters
- ✓ Decide on theme and activities
- ✓ Save the date notice sent out to classroom teachers and students
- ✓ Inform/engage classroom teachers about event and its theme

1 month before event

- ✓ Finalize activity procedures and passport questions
- ✓ Train facilitators
 - o Adult volunteers (need 1-2 training sessions or well-written procedures)
 - o local college students (community service or pre-service teachers; need 1-2 training sessions)
 - o grades 6 12 volunteers (honor society, math club; need 1-2 training sessions)
 - o grade 5 volunteers from your school (need 2-4 training sessions)
- ✓ Choose take home activities and materials

2 weeks before event

- ✓ Gather and/or shop for necessary activity materials
- ✓ Distribute invitations with at-home activity for family
- ✓ Confirm all volunteers

1 week before event

- ✓ Distribute reminder of event
- ✓ Photocopy event agenda, passports and take home brainteaser packet

Day of event

- ✓ Begin set up 60-90 minutes prior to event
- ✓ Run event
- ✓ Have fun!

1 week after event

✓ Debrief using participant evaluations and volunteer feedback
