


Teacher's Guide: Crazy Shapes Activity

Below are examples of how a student might successfully get the marble to follow each path.

<u>Possible solution for zig-zag shape:</u> (two quick puffs of air, as shown)



Possible solution #1: L-shape

Initial motion of marble Multiple puffs of air directly opposite the marble's motion to cause it to slow down and eventually stop at Point A Puff of air to the right once marble is stopped at Point A

Point A: Elbow of L shape

Possible solution #2: L-shape
