Louisville International Airport (SDF)

Just 7 miles from downtown, Louisville International Airport has nonstop service to over 20 destinations and convenient connections to cities worldwide. Shuttle Service

While Louisville does not have a designated airport shuttle service you can make individual reservations through Sandollar Limousine. They provide shuttle service from the airport to all downtown hotels. Reservations can be made [here](#) and must be done in advance.

The Day Tripper pass not only saves visitors money and the hassle of driving, but it also promotes a more environmentally friendly way to travel than a car rental or numerous cab rides. Pick up your Day Tripper pass at the Louisville Visitors Center on 4th and Jefferson and at Union Station, 1000 W. Broadway.
