#### Abstract

Instructions: This document contains the Action Cards for the game in the case study "Disease Along the River." Ideally the cards should be printed out on card stock using a printer that is capable of two-sided printing. Start printing on page 2 so that this instruction page does not print out. The cards are dotted only on one side to assist in cutting. The numbers on the front of the card should match the back. There are a total of ten cards for each villager. Each sheet yields nine cards; the final rainstorm cards ("S" for "Storm") are included at the end of the document. These rainstorm cards are optional-if preferred, the instructor can read out the relevant directions for this part of the game as outlined in the Teaching Notes. If the rainstorm cards are used, they should be inserted between Rounds 4 and 5 once the cards are cut and stacked.
