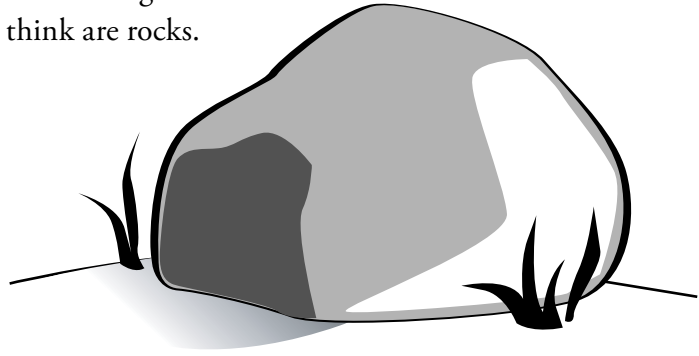


Is It a Rock? (Version 2)
