








Terra cotta: general soil, you can make mountains, valleys, and rivers from this color clay.



Beige: roads or other transportation types (train tracks, bridges, etc.)



Dark brown: agriculture



Dark green: forests or other wildlife habitats.



Plastic houses: these represent areas where humans can build homes
