

Animal Coverings Setup

- Take a gallon sized zip lock bag so that the bag is almost all filled up with the material for each station (the fur, skin, hair, etc.).
- Place a second gallon size Ziploc bag into the material so that the covering fills in around the new bag. This means that there will be a bag surrounded by the material that is in another bag.
- Then staple the edges of the two bags together at the top so that it is stapled the entire around. For safety purposes, cover the row of staples with masking tape so that it prevents scratches.
- The goal is to have the inner bag as a place a student can put their hand which is then insulated by the different animal coverings around the inner bag.
