Requirements:

Assignments for 1 Graduate-Level Credit:

- A. Attend a minimum of 6 of the virtual event sessions.
- B. Write a brief summary of each session/workshop attended. Summarize the session in 150-250 words. Cover the following topics:
 - What can I apply to my teaching?
 - What were the "AHA" moments?
 - What were the strengths?
 - What would have made this session/workshop more valuable to me?
- C. Attach a copy of your NSTA Engage: Fall 20 Attendance certificate.
- D. Share your opinion of this virtual experience! Write up a summary of the pros and cons of virtual conferences. What parts of this can you translate to your own virtual classroom setting?

Assignments for 2 Graduate-Level Credits: (In addition to requirements above)

Participants earning 2 graduate-level credits must attend a minimum of 2 days of the event. The participant will complete the 1 credit assignments above plus these additional requirements:

- A. Attend an additional 2 virtual event sessions. (Write-up each session as above.)
- B. Attend at least 3 resource sessions. The resource sessions will give you a short glimpse into a topic of interest. For each of the 3 resources sessions that you attend, research further into the classroom use of the topic and create a lesson plan to illustrate the implementation of the concept in the session. Each write up should be a minimum of 2 pages and include the following:
 - Summary of the resource session.
 - Additional research, including references.
 - Lesson plan illustrating how the idea will be implemented your classroom.
- C. Share your virtual event experience! Write up or design a presentation that you can use to share your virtual event ideas with your classroom students, faculty, department, PTA, or at a Staff training.

Accreditation & Types of Credits/Units

The Continuing Education and Professional Development division of The School of Liberal Arts and Education is responsible for all the course listed on this syllabus.
