# Purpose

The NSTA Council is composed of eighteen District Directors representing the 50 States, Canada, Guam, American Samoa, Territory of the Pacific Islands, Puerto Rico, and Virgin Islands. The Council Affiliate Directors represent the seven NSTA Affiliates. In addition NSTA has several associated groups which share similar missions.

Some have commented that they feel that they are frequently "reinventing the wheel" as each group strives to serve science educators.

#### <u>Mission</u>

The National Association for Research in Science Teaching (NARST) is a worldwide organization of professionals committed to the improvement of science teaching and learning through research. Since its inception in 1928, NARST has promoted research in science education and the communication of knowledge generated by the research. The ultimate goal of NARST is to help all learners achieve science literacy. NARST promotes this goal by: 1) encouraging and supporting the application of diverse research methods and theoretical perspectives from multiple disciplines to the investigation of teaching and learning in science; 2) communicating science education research findings to researchers, practitioners, and policy makers; and 3) cooperating with other educational and scientific societies to influence educational policies.

#### History\*

Started in 1928 by a founding group of 17 science educators, NARST is the oldest surviving science education society in the U.S. The first president of NARST, W. L. Eikenberry, along with the other founders, had wanted to form a national organization for science teachers, which would include teachers from all levels and with varying roles, including their own as college professors of teacher education. In 1933, NARST members assisted with the formation of ASTA, the American Science Teachers Association (ASTA). Harry Carpenter, NARST member, was the first president of ASTA, and served (1941-1942) as NARST president. In 1942, NARST member, Ira Davis, chaired a subcommittee of the National Committee on Science Teaching of the NEA that created the American Council of Science Teachers (ACST). In 1944, under the leadership of NARST members Philip Johnson and Morris Meister, ASTA and ACST were merged to form the NSTA. In 1961, NARST was incorporated in the state of Minnesota, and articles of incorporation were signed by eight NARST members.

#### Annual Meeting

Since its founding in 1928, NARST has held annual national meetings, except during the war years, 1943-46 (regional meetings were held in 1943 and 1944, and no meetings were held in 1945-46). The early meetings were all held in the northeast quadrant of the US, in cities readily accessible by train. The coming of jet planes made it possible for members to travel almost anywhere in the US. The first west coast meeting was in 1969 in Pasadena. The first international meeting was in Toronto in 1978. NARST has frequently held its annual meeting synchronously with other educational organizations. For example, NARST met with the National Council of Supervisor of Elementary Science, which later became CESI, in 1932 and at least 13 other times. NARST has also met synchronously with AERA since 1934, and began meeting in association with NSTA in the 1960's. In 1970 the NARST Board approved a policy of meeting in alternate years with AERA and NSTA, a policy that is still in effect. In 2000 and 2001 attendance at the annual meeting exceeded 900.

The National Association for Research in Science Teaching (Cont.) Journals

The journal, Science Education, served as NARST's official journal for 33 years. However, the NARST board had no editorial or policy making control of this journal, and eventually become frustrated with this situation. In 1962 NARST's ties with Science Education were severed and a new plan for communicating the work of NARST members was put into place. In May, 1963, the first issue of the Journal of Research in Science Teaching (JRST), under the editorship of Stanley Marshall, was published by John Wiley and Sons. In 2001 the journal saw its first female co-editor, Dale Baker, along with Mike Piburn, Arizona State University. The journal is published in 10 issues per year, has a team of associate editors, and editorial review board, and numerous guest reviewers among the NARST membership.

Membership

Membership in NARST grew from the original 17 founders in 1928 to 70 in 1936. The next jump occurred in 1947 when the membership achieved 111. Membership grew steadily to over 300 in 1963, and to over 500 two years later. In 1972, the membership was just over 900, where it remained for 20 years. In the 1990's, the membership experienced a growth spurt, and in 2000, NARST had over 1800 members. The first female member of NARST was Florence Billig, who gave the first annual meeting presentation by a woman in 1930 and served as president from 1943-1945. The fist black member of NARST was Thomas Fraser, who joined in 1949 and was elected president in 1959. The first international member to attend a NARST meeting was a German who presented a paper at the 1931 annual meeting. Almost one third of the current membership is international.

Along with its journal, NARST communicates with its members via the NARST listserv, the NARST web site (www.narst.org), and the NARST News, a biannual newsletter of the association. Membership includes all of these, plus reduced prices on NARST monographs and annual meeting registration. Governance

NARST is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of 13 elected members: President, President-elect, Past president, Research Coordinator, and 9 Directorsat-Large; and other members who serve the board in non-voting status: Executive Secretary, NSTA Representative, JRST editors. Board members chair NARST Standing Committees: Policy Advisory, Financial Advisory, Publications Advisory, Program, Research, Election, International, JRST Award, NARST Outstanding Paper Award, Distinguished Contribution through Research Award, Early Career Research Award, Outstanding Doctoral Research Award, Outstanding Master's Research Award, Equity, and Membership. Ad hoc committees are appointed by the President to carry out specific charges. The Annual Meeting Coordinator assists with arrangements for the annual meeting. Other positions in the association include the newsletter editor and the director of electronic services.

#### SOCIETY FOR COLLEGE SCIENCE TEACHERS

The Society for College Science Teachers (SCST) was established on March 24, 1979 at the NSTA convention in Atlanta, Georgia. The major goal of the Society is to improve the teaching of college science courses via interdisciplinary interactions among teachers of college science. In April 1981, SCST became an official affiliate of NSTA, increasing the services available to college science teachers in the pursuit of their personal and professional objectives.

SCST is governed by an executive board, members of which oversee the work of committees and state membership co-ordinators. The board meets twice yearly, at the NSTA national convention and one of the area conventions. Current membership is about 1000.

Members of SCST receive the Journal of College Science Teaching and frequently publish contributions in it, including the SCST president's column in every issue. SCST publishes three issues yearly of the Newsletter, distributed to all members, and continues publication of a series of monographs on aspects of college science teaching. Six volumes have been published to date. The Society offers mini grants up to \$1000 to members for projects that enhance quality in college science teaching, communication among teachers and awareness of exceptional science teaching.

SCST participates in the programs of NSTA conventions, filling ten hours at the national convention and two at each area convention, largely with submitted papers from members. The SCST portion of the program at the national convention includes the Marjorie Gardner Lecture, named for a former president of the Society and presented by the previous year's winner of the SCST/Kendall-Hunt Outstanding Undergraduate Science Teacher Award. This award, which includes an honorarium of \$1000, given for excellence in teaching, scholarship and service, is presented each year at the College Luncheon at the national convention. An annual volume of Programs and Abstracts from the conventions is distributed to all members.
